126 **Section 2530.230 Point System**

- 128 a) Any person pleads guilty to, is found guilty of, receives court supervision, or is  
129 sentenced to conditional discharge by a circuit court of the State of Illinois

130 ~~(including supervision or conditional discharge)~~ or a United States District Court  
131 in an Illinois District of an offense that is a violation of any of the provisions of  
132 the Fish and Aquatic Life Code, the Wildlife Code, the Timber Buyers Licensing  
133 Act, the Ginseng Harvesting Act, the Endangered Species Act, the Herptiles-  
134 Herps Act or any similar violation of federal statutes or rules, or any violation  
135 under Section 48-3(b) of the Criminal Code of 2012 [720 ILCS 5/48-3(b)] and as  
136 authorized by any statute referenced in this subsection shall be assessed points as  
137 set out in Section 2530.240.

138  
139 b) Licenses, permits and stamps shall be revoked, and privileges shall be suspended,  
140 based upon the accumulated points. The assessed accumulated points remain  
141 until:

- 142  
143 1) In cases involving Type I offenses (see Section 2530.255), 18 months has  
144 elapsed since the date of the commission of the offense;
- 145  
146 2) In cases involving Type II offenses, 36 months has elapsed since the date  
147 of the commission of the offense;
- 148  
149 3) An order of the Circuit Court or the Director terminates the suspension  
150 and the applicable reinstatement fee has been paid and processed by the  
151 Department; or
- 152  
153 4) An order of the Circuit Court has expunged the underlying record of the  
154 offense, the Office of Law Enforcement has received notice of the  
155 expungement, and the applicable reinstatement fee has been paid.
