HOUSE RESOLUTIONS

The following resolutions were offered and placed in the Committee on Rules.

HOUSE RESOLUTION 837

Offered by Representative Du Buclet:

WHEREAS, There are more than 300 medically recognized headache diseases, including cluster headaches and migraine; and

WHEREAS, Migraine is a genetic, neurobiological disease characterized by episodes known as attacks; and

WHEREAS, Headache diseases impact one in four households in the United States, with more than 42 million Americans living with headache diseases, including approximately four million who have chronic migraine, meaning they experience 15 or more migraine attacks each month; and

WHEREAS, Headache diseases are three to four times more prevalent in women, and Native/Indigenous communities have the highest prevalence of disabling headaches in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Significant disparities in diagnosis, treatment, and outcomes for headache diseases persist, particularly affecting Black, Hispanic, and Native/Indigenous populations who face underdiagnosis and inadequate treatment; and

WHEREAS, It is estimated that 40 to 50% of persons living with migraine disease are undiagnosed; and

WHEREAS, Migraine is the second leading cause of global disability, and notably one of the most disabling for women under 50 years old; and

WHEREAS, Approximately one in 1,000 people in the United States live with cluster headache disease, medically referred to as one of the most painful conditions a human can experience; and

WHEREAS, Veterans returning from Iraq and Afghanistan have two to four times the incidence of migraine compared to the general population, likely due to Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBI), and posttraumatic headache occurs in up to 92% of military personnel who have sustained mild TBIs; and

WHEREAS, Headache diseases are an economic issue, costing U.S. companies upwards of \$78 billion dollars each year in direct and indirect costs; and

WHEREAS, The effects of headache diseases are experienced on a spectrum, presenting with significantly different levels of intensity, frequency, and disability; and

WHEREAS, Migraine disease impacts all systems of the body, and symptoms may include intense pain, nausea and vomiting, sensitivity to light, sound, smell, and touch, visual disturbances, tinnitus, chills, fatigue, anomic aphasia, or trouble finding words, impaired cognitive function, and numbness and weakness, lasting for four to 72 hours on average; and

WHEREAS, Stigma and misinformation related to headache disease have stifled research and advances in treatment; and

WHEREAS, All persons living with headache diseases deserve fair, equal, timely, and affordable access to new and innovative treatments to live their lives to their fullest potential; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare the month of June 2024 as Migraine and Headache Awareness Month in the State of Illinois.

HOUSE RESOLUTION 840

Offered by Representative Cassidy:

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has repeatedly emphasized the importance of timely and accessible mental health services; and

WHEREAS, The number of individuals facing mental health challenges in Illinois continues to rise at an alarming rate; and

WHEREAS, Mental health issues affect individuals across every socioeconomic status; and

WHEREAS, It is critically important to provide necessary assistance to those experiencing mental health challenges; and

WHEREAS, The provision of community-based mental health services varies greatly across the State; and

WHEREAS, Numerous facilities that previously provided inpatient mental health care have been eliminated and closed over the past few decades; and

WHEREAS, Efforts have been made and continue to be made to bring mental health services to those in need; and

WHEREAS, These efforts have not been sufficient to meet the growing mental health needs of Illinois citizens; and

WHEREAS, The impact of the COVID-19 pandemic has significantly exacerbated the already existing problem of unmet mental health service needs; and

WHEREAS, Mental health service providers face increasing challenges in finding necessary staffing to address the growing mental health needs of the people of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Many individuals with unmet mental health needs have become entangled in the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, Numerous individuals facing mental health struggles have been incarcerated in county jails, environments not suited for addressing or treating mental health problems; and

WHEREAS, Many individuals with mental illness are found unfit to stand trial by the courts and are ordered to the Department of Human Services (DHS) for restoration to competency; and

WHEREAS, DHS was previously required to assign such individuals to an inpatient facility within 20 days of being found unfit to stand trial, after which the local county sheriff would transfer them; and

WHEREAS, DHS has successfully passed legislation to change that timeline to 60 days, with the possibility of additional 30-day extensions in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, These extensions have placed significant burdens on county resources, diverting valuable time and attention away from the critical issues that county personnel are specifically trained and mandated to address, not only hampering the efficiency of our county systems but also undermining the well-being and safety of our communities; and

WHEREAS, This change in timeline has exacerbated the situation for those in need of mental health treatment, leaving individuals incarcerated when they should be receiving critical services from DHS; and

WHEREAS, The mental health crisis continues to grow with no end in sight; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Department of Human Services (DHS) to work with stakeholders, including sheriffs, to submit monthly reports to the General Assembly detailing the number of available beds, the number of individuals needing mental health services on the waiting list, staffing changes implemented to support improvements, and the waiting time from the receipt of the judge's order for individuals deemed unfit to stand trial to when they begin receiving services; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be delivered to the Department of Human Services.

Representative Ugaste introduced the following:

**HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 21**

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to amend Section 19 of Article VI of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

**ARTICLE VI
THE JUDICIARY**

(ILCON Art. VI, Sec. 19)

SECTION 19. STATE'S ATTORNEYS - SELECTION, SALARY

A State's Attorney shall be elected in each county in 1972 and every fourth year thereafter for a four year term. One State's Attorney may be elected to serve two or more counties if the governing boards of such counties so provide and a majority of the electors of each county voting on the issue approve. A person shall not be eligible for the office of State's Attorney unless he is a United States citizen and a licensed attorney-at-law of this State. His salary shall be provided by law. A State's Attorney in a county with a population over 2,000,000 may be recalled by petition and referendum of the electors of the county or counties served by the State's Attorney in a manner provided by law.
