**HOUSE RESOLUTIONS**

The following resolutions were offered and placed in the Committee on Rules.

**HOUSE RESOLUTION 959**

Offered by Representative Ladisch Douglass:

WHEREAS, Celiac disease is one of the world's most prevalent genetic autoimmune diseases, affecting an estimated three million Americans, 70-80% of whom are undiagnosed; and

WHEREAS, Celiac disease causes the body to attack its own small intestine, which can lead to many other devastating health conditions, including cancer; and

WHEREAS, Celiac disease results in extraordinary economic and productivity costs to both the public and private sectors from employee and student absenteeism, as well as repeated, inconclusive visits to healthcare providers; and

WHEREAS, On average, it takes four years to be correctly diagnosed with celiac disease; and

WHEREAS, There is no medication or cure for celiac disease; the only treatment is a lifelong, strict gluten-free diet; and

WHEREAS, Studies show that up to 50% of people on a gluten-free diet continue to experience symptoms and have intestinal damage, revealing the ineffectiveness of the gluten-free diet as a treatment; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare September 13, 2024 as Celiac Disease Awareness Day in the State of Illinois to raise public awareness of this serious condition; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage support for improving the quality of life and health of individuals with celiac disease by advancing biomedical research to develop diagnostic tools, life-improving treatments, and a cure.

#### HOUSE RESOLUTION 960

Offered by Representative Miller:

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has established laws, including the Reimagining Electric Vehicles Act (REV) and the Invest in Illinois Act (Closing Fund), that use State funds to attract clean energy manufacturers; and

WHEREAS, On September 8, 2023, the Pritzker Administration announced a REV deal with Gotion, Inc., the subsidiary of Chinese-owned Gotion High-tech, to build an electric vehicle battery factory in Manteno; and

WHEREAS, According to the Illinois comptroller's database, Gotion has been awarded upfront direct payments totaling \$125 million as part of a total \$536 million incentive package from the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Gotion, Inc. is estimated to be eligible for an additional \$7 billion from the federal government in green energy tax subsidies; and

WHEREAS, At a time when the electric vehicle market is imploding, as proven by companies such as Ford, General Motors, Volkswagen, and others that are ending or scaling back future production of electric vehicles, the State of Illinois is committing even more taxpayer money to these fledgling industries while other Illinois businesses are denied the same incentives; and

WHEREAS, A letter from the U.S. House Select Committee on the Chinese Communist Party to the Department of Homeland Security revealed evidence implicating Chinese battery manufacturer Gotion, Inc. for its ties to state-sponsored slave labor and perpetuating the ongoing Uyghur genocide; and

WHEREAS, According to the Center for Strategic & International Studies (CSIS), since 2000, at least 224 publicly reported cases have been found of Chinese espionage of the U.S. government and U.S. companies with estimations of billions of dollars in commercial and technological espionage, far outnumbering any of other country in reported cases; and

WHEREAS, The governments of the United States and the State of Illinois should not under any circumstance give tax payer money to a foreign company owned by a country designated by United States federal regulation and the U.S. Congress as a country of concern, including the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Cuba, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the Russian Federation, and Venezuela; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Governor to rescind the REV agreement with Gotion, Inc. effective immediately; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we urge the General Assembly to pass legislation to ban any future State incentives from going to any corporation owned and operated by a foreign country of concern as designated by Congress; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to the Governor, the Comptroller, the Speaker of the House, the Senate President, and each member of the Illinois Congressional Delegation.

#### HOUSE RESOLUTION 963

Offered by Representative Walsh:

WHEREAS, Many electric, water, and natural gas customers throughout the country are being targeted by impostor utility scams each day; scammers typically use phone, in-person, and online tactics to target customers; and

WHEREAS, Often, there is an uptick in utility scams during the holiday season when customers may be rushed, paying less attention to warning signs, or are more concerned about finances; scammers may call residential or business customers threatening disconnection and demanding immediate payment; and

WHEREAS, In recent years, utilities have seen increased reports of their customers being contacted by scammers who pose as utility workers in an attempt to access their financial information or to obtain immediate payment by threatening service interruptions; these are known as utility impostor scams; and

WHEREAS, It is important that customers know to take precautions and call their utilities directly to check on the status of their accounts if they are ever unsure about the authenticity of a caller or the identity of a service worker or if they suspect any fraudulent activity; and

WHEREAS, Utilities will never ask for payments using a pre-paid debit card, gift card, cryptocurrencies, or third-party digital payment mobile applications, and they will provide multiple notices before any service interruptions are implemented; and

WHEREAS, Customers who suspect that they have been victims of fraud or who feel threatened during contact with a scammer should contact their local utility company or their local law enforcement authorities; the Federal Trade Commission also provides additional information about protecting personal information and other information regarding impostor scams; and

WHEREAS, Raising awareness and educating customers about scams is a top priority for Utilities United Against Scams (UUAS); UUAS helps to spread awareness of the suspicious behaviors and the evolving tactics that scammers use to target customers; and

WHEREAS, UUAS has declared November 20, 2024 as Utility Scam Awareness Day in an advocacy and awareness campaign focused on educating customers and exposing scammer tactics; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare November 20, 2024 as Utility Scam Awareness Day in the State of Illinois.

#### HOUSE RESOLUTION 976

WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., founded at Howard University on November 17, 1911, stands as a beacon of excellence in service, education, and leadership within the African American community and beyond; and
