WHEREAS, The National Safety Council (NSC) in partnership with the Illinois Secretary of State (IL SOS) holds that safe driving is a lifelong journey of learning and skill development and age alone should not determine driving ability; and

WHEREAS, U.S. Census data shows that while our nation's demographics are evolving, NSC research demonstrates that age alone is not a determining factor in driving ability; and

WHEREAS, The overall crash rate per 100,000 licensed drivers steadily decreases as driver age increases; and

WHEREAS, NSC supports comprehensive, evidence-based approaches to traffic safety that focus on actual driving capabilities rather than demographic factors; and

WHEREAS, A 2023 Illinois Department of Transportation study showed that Illinois drivers 75 and older had lower crash rates when compared to other age groups; and

WHEREAS, In 2024, out of 55,000 Illinois drivers between 79 and 86 who were required to take a behind-the-wheel driver test, only 97, or 0.17%, failed the test and were denied driver's licenses; and

WHEREAS, NSC encourages families to have open, honest conversations about safe driving with their loved ones, recognizing that understanding modern vehicle safety features can help maintain independence while enhancing safety; and

WHEREAS, NSC, in partnership with the IL SOS, continues to advocate for safe driving initiatives that protect all road users; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the citizens and licensed drivers of Illinois to emphasize safe driving by practicing safe driving behaviors and prioritizing driver improvement and education for themselves and for their friends and family to eliminate preventable deaths on our nation's roadways.

HOUSE RESOLUTION 404

Offered by Representative Benton:

WHEREAS, It is imperative for State agencies to regulate the use of electrical lights in State buildings and facilities to better conserve energy and to minimize light pollution; and

WHEREAS, It is the policy of this State to make every effort to reduce the amount of energy that is unnecessarily used and to minimize light pollution; and

WHEREAS, Turning off electrical lights whenever possible in State buildings and facilities saves energy that translates to lower energy bills and a smaller carbon footprint; and

WHEREAS, Shutting off lights when not in use also reduces light pollution from unnecessary artificial light at night that can harm wildlife, disrupt natural behaviors, and diminish the visibility of the night sky; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we encourage State agencies to regulate the use of electrical lights in State buildings and facilities to better conserve energy and to minimize light pollution, and we urge electrical lights in State buildings and facilities to be turned off unless the building or facility or that part of it is occupied, unless the building or facility is open 24-hours a day, limited to the areas and floors that are occupied, or unless the lighting is required for security or safety purposes; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias and all State agencies.

HOUSE RESOLUTION 409

WHEREAS, Every day, 125 people in the United States are killed by gun violence, and more than 260 people are shot and wounded, with an average of more than 19,000 gun homicides every year; and

WHEREAS, In January 2013, Hadiya Pendleton was tragically shot and killed at age 15, and on June 6, 2025, to recognize her 28th birthday, June 2, 1997, people across the United States will recognize National Gun Violence Awareness Day and wear orange in tribute to Hadiya Pendleton and other victims of gun violence and the loved ones of those victims; and

WHEREAS, This idea was inspired by a group of Hadiya Pendleton's friends who asked their classmates to commemorate her life by wearing orange; they chose this color because hunters wear orange to announce themselves to other hunters when out in the woods, and orange is a color that symbolizes the value of human life; and

WHEREAS, Anyone can join this campaign by pledging to wear orange on June 6th, the first Friday in June 2025, to help raise awareness about gun violence; and

WHEREAS, By wearing orange on June 6, 2025, people across the United States will raise awareness about gun violence and honor the lives of gun violence victims and survivors; and

WHEREAS, A commitment to reduce gun violence and a pledge to do all we can to keep firearms out of the hands of people who should not have access to them and encourage responsible gun ownership will help keep our families and communities safe; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare June 6, 2025 as Gun Violence Awareness Day in the State of Illinois, and we encourage all citizens to support their communities' efforts to prevent the tragic effects of gun violence and to honor and value human lives.
