RE: Report pursuant to 410 ILCS 45/12.1

Dear Members of the General Assembly:

The Office of the Attorney General is required pursuant to 410 ILCS 45/12.1 (P.A. 94-0879) to annually report to the General Assembly the number of lead poisoning cases that have been referred to the Office of the Attorney General by the Illinois Department of Public Health for enforcement due to violations of the Lead Poisoning Prevention Act (the "Act") or for failure to comply with a notice of deficiency and mitigation order issued pursuant to subsection (7) of Section 9 of the Act.

Please be advised that last year, the Office of the Attorney General received four referrals for enforcement for failure to comply with a notice of deficiency and mitigation order issued pursuant to subsection (7) of Section 9 of the Act, and one referral to obtain an administrative inspection warrant pursuant to Section 8.2 of the Act, from the Illinois Department of Public Health between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2023.
