# Introduction

Metropolitan Enforcement Groups (MEGs) continue to be an important component in the effort to combat illicit drug, illegally possessed firearms, and human trafficking throughout Illinois. MEGs collaborate with state, federal, and local law enforcement agencies to enforce Illinois drug laws, investigate street gang activity, and participate in proactive human trafficking operations aimed at recovering victims. MEGs partner with the Statewide Terrorism Intelligence Center (STIC) and Illinois National Guard Counterdrug analysts to reduce crime through intelligence-led policing with focused enforcement efforts on felony level drug distribution. MEG partnerships with community groups, local stakeholders, and drug treatment providers have led MEGs to adjust their focus on not only enforcement, but treatment of substance use disorders in the communities they serve.

The nine MEGs span across 20 Illinois counties, including Scott County Iowa, with these Illinois counties populous of 3,821,524 people, or 31% of the state's overall population. Each MEG is overseen by a policy board consisting of Illinois State Police, elected county sheriffs, and law enforcement chiefs, or their designees. The nine MEGs are staffed by 80 total sworn officers, 24 from ISP, and 56 officers from local and federal agencies. Administrative staff account for 21 positions that are tasked with managing budgets, monthly reporting, intelligence data, and asset seizures.

The MEGs unit's effectiveness was highlighted in a 2017 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) report that found they were more effective than their local counterparts in felony drug arrests and drug trafficking enforcement. MEGs are also active in addressing human trafficking by working with intelligence-based software to locate and recover victims. This broadens their impact, showing that their role goes beyond drug-related crime and contributes to addressing human exploitation. The annual MEG report includes statewide activity totals as well as individual activity for each MEG unit, including arrest statistics, drug and gun seizures, gang arrests and human trafficking statistics for calendar year 2024.

## **Community Partnerships**

Metropolitan Enforcement Groups (MEGs) are on the front line of narcotic enforcement strategies, prevention, and treatment strategies. Through community partnerships forged through TASC (Treatment Alternative for Safe Communities), MEGs increase awareness of drug abuse trends and work with various groups to keep drug abusers out of the criminal justice system by focusing enforcement efforts on felony level drug distribution and trafficking.
