In accordance with 430 ILCS 65/11, a report listing all final decisions by a court of this State upholding, reversing, or reversing in part, any administrative decisions made by the Firearm Owner's Identification Card Review Board ("FCRB") concerning the Firearm Owners Identification ("FOID") Card Act must be submitted to you and the General Assembly. The FCRB received 12 relevant decisions from the Illinois courts during calendar year 2024, with respect to FOID card litigation. Enclosed is a summary of those cases, including information regarding one case that remains pending on appeal.

**430 ILCS 65/11(c)**

**Petitions for Relief Brought Under 430 ILCS 65/10**

In 12 relevant cases, the petitioner sought relief from the relevant firearm prohibition and/or an order directing ISP to issue a FOID card under the provisions of 430 ILCS 65/10, the court denied or dismissed the petitioner's request for issuance of a FOID card in 6 instances.

1. *Abusharif, Zachary v. Illinois FOID Card Review Board* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Abusharif's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Abusharif subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On June 14, 2024, Mr. Abusharif filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.
2. *Dorsey, Ruth v. Craig Findley and Illinois FCRB* -- Illinois State Police revoked Ms. Dorsey's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Ms. Dorsey subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying her request. On February 20, 2024, Ms. Dorsey filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.
3. *Edwards, Anthony v. Illinois FCRB* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Edwards's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Edwards subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On November 15, 2023, Mr. Edwards filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. The Petition was withdrawn, and the case was dismissed. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.
4. *Harrington, Mellowiece v. Illinois FCRB* -- Illinois State Police revoked Ms. Harrington's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Ms. Harrington subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying her request. On November 20, 2023, Ms. Harrington filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.
5. *Iskowitz, Brandon v. Illinois FCRB* -- The Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Iskowitz's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Iskowitz subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On July 5, 2024, Mr. Iskowitz filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Kendall County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. The Petition was withdrawn, and the case was dismissed. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.

6. *McKinney, v. Illinois State Police* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. McKinney's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. McKinney subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On July 10, 2024, Mr. McKinney filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Adams County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order, the case was dismissed. FCRB decision affirmed, petition denied.

The court granted relief and directed ISP to issue a FOID card to the petitioner in 6 instances. In all of those cases, FCRB did not appeal the orders.

1. *English, Sean v. Illinois FOID Card Review Board, et. Al+* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. English's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. English subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On November 6, 2023, Mr. English filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
2. *Faulkner, John v. Honorable Richard Schoenstedt and ISP* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Faulkner's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Faulkner subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On April 8, 2024, Mr. Faulker filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Marion County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
3. *Huskey, Jennifer v. FOID Card Review Board and ISP* -- Illinois State Police revoked Ms. Huskey's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Ms. Huskey subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying her request. On November 16, 2023, Ms. Huskey filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Piatt County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
4. *Odom, Damonte v. Illinois FCRB* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Odom's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Odom subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On December 22, 2023, Mr. Odom filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
5. *Smith, Delicia v. FOID Card Review Board and ISP* -- Illinois State Police revoked Ms. Smith's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Ms. Smith subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying her request. On March 1, 2024, Ms. Smith filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
6. *Smith, Luke v. Illinois FOID Card Review Board and ISP* -- Illinois State Police revoked Mr. Smith's FOID card as issuance is contrary to federal law. Mr. Smith subsequently filed a petition for relief with the FOID Card Review Board ("FCRB"), which issued a final administrative order denying his request. On March 12 2024, Mr. Smith filed a Petition in the Circuit Court of Will County seeking *de novo* judicial review of the FCRB's final

administrative order. Petition granted, ISP to issue FOID card.
