AGENCY OVERVIEW

In 2024, the Warrenville Police Department employed 32 full-time sworn Officers, one part-time sworn Officer, and two full-time Community Service Officers. Each of the 35 Department members was issued their individual *Axon Body 4* Body Worn Camera (BWC).

TECHNICAL ISSUES

No technical issues with any BWCs has been discovered.

REVIEW PROCESS

Policy 451 covers the review process for body worn cameras:

451.15 SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY

- d. Monthly, supervisors will randomly review 10 recordings pertaining to his/her area of responsibility to ensure that the equipment is operating properly and that officers are using the cameras appropriately and in accordance with this policy and training.
 - a. The selection of recordings will be conducted in an impartial manner that promotes an equitable review of recordings from all officers under the supervisor's chain of command.
 - b. Supervisors shall not review recordings for the sole purpose of searching for violations of Department policy or law not related to a specific complaint or incident.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

The Warrenville Police Department began using Axon BWC in August 2021, and also utilizes Axon Fleet 3 in-squad cameras for all marked squads.
