



2024 ILETSB Body-Worn Camera Report

Agency Overview

In 2024, the Lindenhurst Police Department employed 15 full-time and 4 part-time sworn officers. The Department's body-worn camera program was implemented in March of 2024 after purchasing Motorola V300 body-worn cameras for all sworn personnel. The Department owns 21 body-worn cameras and every sworn officer is issued their own body-worn camera.

Technical Issues

No technical issues were noted during the year.

Review Process

Policy 439 covers the review process for body-worn cameras.

439.7.1 Access and Use of BWC Media

- e. Supervisors are permitted to access and view BWC media of their subordinates.
 - 1. Supervisors should review BWC media that is tagged as a significant event or that the supervisor is aware pertains to a significant event.
 - 2. Supervisors should conduct documented reviews of their subordinate's BWC media at least annually to evaluate the member's performance, verify compliance with Lindenhurst Police Department procedures, and determine the need for additional training. The review should include a variety of event types when possible. Supervisors should review BWC media with the recording member

when it would be beneficial to provide guidance or to conduct one-on-one informal training for the member.

3. Supervisors should conduct periodic reviews of a sample of each subordinate's BWC media to evaluate BWC use and ensure compliance with this policy.
- f. The Training Commander is permitted to access and view BWC media for training purposes.
 1. The Training Commander should conduct a quarterly review of a random sampling of BWC media to evaluate Lindenhurst Police Department performance and effectiveness and to identify specific areas where additional training or changes to protocols would be beneficial. Training Committee members may review BWC media as part of their review to identify training needs.

Other Relevant Information

The Lindenhurst Police Department utilizes Motorola M500 in-car cameras in all marked and one unmarked squad cars. These cameras record in sync with the body-worn cameras.
