2024 Burbank Police Department ILETSB Body-Worn Camera Report

- **Number of Body-Worn Cameras:** On May 3, 2023, the Burbank Police Department launched its body-worn camera program, utilizing 20 cameras equipped with 40 interchangeable batteries.
- **Number of Officers:** In 2024, 47 full-time Burbank Police Officers utilized body-worn cameras.
- **Technical Issues:** In 2022, the Burbank Police Department entered into a five-year leasing agreement for body-worn cameras with its service provider. Under the terms of the agreement, if a body-worn camera becomes defective, a service ticket is submitted through the provider's customer portal, and a replacement unit is shipped to the Department. The defective device is then returned to the service provider.

In 2024, two body-worn cameras were removed from service and returned due to defects. The specific technical issues encountered were as follows: the first device failed to record video while continuing to record audio, and the second experienced damage to an internal component.

- **Supervisor Review Process:** In accordance with Burbank Police Department policy, supervisors are authorized to review relevant body-worn camera recordings when investigating allegations of misconduct, reports of meritorious conduct, or whenever such review would aid in evaluating a member's performance. If a supervisor reviews body-worn camera footage prior to completing a report or other documentation, the review must be noted within the report or accompanying records.
