Please find below the information required about the body-worn cameras and Fleet 3 in-car video recorders used by the Bartlett Police Department.

Department Makeup

The Bartlett Police Department initiated a Body-Worn Camera (BWC) program in February 2024. Approximately 63 sworn officers have been issued BWCs and must wear them in any law enforcement context. AXON manufactures all BWCs and in-car video recording equipment.

Technical Issues

The department has not experienced any technical issues with BWC or in-car video recordings. The previous issue of sending large files from our department to the State Attorney's Office has been resolved. Bartlett is situated in three counties: Cook, DuPage, and Kane, and is able to transfer cases as needed.

Review

All videos that contain any use of force are reviewed by a Sergeant, Commander, Deputy Chief, and Chief to ensure adherence to laws and policy. Other videos are reviewed randomly for monthly video checks or when complaints arise.
