Agency Overview

The Elgin Community College Police Department consists of sixteen (16) sworn officers who utilize sixteen (16) body worn cameras. The department implemented body worn cameras in July 2024.

Technical Issues

The Elgin Community College Police Department did not experience any technical issues in 2024.

Review Process

When a supervisor becomes aware that a recorded incident pertains to a critical incident, the supervisor shall review only those recordings necessary and relevant to their investigative scope. The supervisor is responsible for forwarding the information to the chief. In addition, supervisors shall ensure that a sampling of BWC recordings pertaining to the work groups under their command are reviewed. The purpose of this review is to ensure that the BWC equipment is operating properly and that officers are using the cameras appropriately and in accordance with policy and training.
