Dwight Police Department Annual Body Worn Camera Report

1. The Dwight Police Department currently consists of (8) full-time officers and (2) part-time officers. We have approval of having (10) full-time officers. The Dwight Police Department has (13) Motorola Body cameras. We currently have (10) cameras assigned to Officers and Supervisors. It should be noted however that not all (13) cameras were always assigned due to normal and expected fluctuations of assignments and manpower issues (e.g. Leaves of absence, light duty, and so on).
2. As stated above, the Dwight Police Department has a total of (13) Motola Body cameras, with (10) currently being utilized.
3. From January 1, 2025, through May 1, 2025, the only technical issues that have been reported is the Body camera not always syncing with the in-car camera system. This issue is continually being addressed by checking in car docking stations and making sure all cables and Wi-Fi are connected correctly.
4. The Dwight Police Departments Body Worn Camera review process consists of random video reviews of every Officer issued a Body Worn Camera. This review is conducted by the Chief of Police and a Supervisor. It should be noted that the Dwight Police Department is currently working with Lexipol updating policy and procedures.
5. The Dwight Police Department is not currently under any ILETSB Grant Funding.
6. No other information relevant to the administration of the program. Note: If this report is not sufficient or not within compliance with the Agency Body Camera Reporting act to ILETSB please contact me with recommendations.
