To the Honorable Members of the General Assembly:

The Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA), 815 ILCS 530/1 *et seq.*, requires State agencies to notify the General Assembly of the unauthorized disclosure of private information. This letter is to notify you that an unauthorized disclosure of information has occurred due to a .csv report published on the Illinois Liquor Control Commission's (ILCC) website that included SSN numbers in the FEIN Column of 572 individuals. The ILCC has opened an investigation into the matter with the Illinois Department of Innovation and Technology (DoIT).

The ILCC is in the process of notifying the individuals who were affected by the unauthorized disclosure of information. The ILCC and DoIT have removed the unauthorized data from the ILCC website and are working to ensure that this error does not happen again, as the privacy of our licensees is of paramount importance to us.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of this occurrence in accordance with PIPA. There is no action required on your part. If you have any questions or comments, please contact us at ILCC.Legal@illinois.gov.
