Explanation of Transfers by the Department of the Lottery

Transfers to the Common School Fund

In accordance with 20 ILCS 1605/9.3, the Illinois Department of the Lottery (Department) is statutorily mandated to transfer estimated net proceeds to the Common School Fund (CSF) on a monthly basis. The transfer shall be made on the last day of each month or shortly thereafter. The estimated proceeds transferred monthly are to be reconciled to actual proceeds upon completion of the applicable annual fiscal year audit. If actual net proceeds are more than estimated net proceeds, the remaining amount shall be deposited in the CSF. If actual net proceeds are less than estimated net proceeds, the excess amount shall offset estimated net lottery proceeds the following fiscal year. The net lottery proceeds shall be determined after deducting prizes, retailer bonuses, costs incurred in the operation and administration of the Lottery, and transfers to specialty causes. Additionally, they shall be determined in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) for governmental entities.

The CSF estimated net proceed transfers made in June 2025 totaled **\$65 million** and were made on June 4th, June 11th, June 18th, and June 27th.

Transfers to Specialty Causes

Per the Illinois Lottery Law (20 ILCS 1605/21.4 thru 21.16), the Illinois Department of the Lottery shall offer a joint special instant scratch-off game for ten various causes as outlined in the Law. The Department transfers the net proceeds from these causes to the specified funds within the State of Illinois on a monthly basis. The net proceeds are transferred one month in arrears of the revenues being generated and upon final reconciliation of instant sales, less prize expense, and operating expenses of the joint ticket. During June, the special causes the Department supports earned net proceeds of **\$926 thousand**. This amount was cash transferred in July. Additionally, the Department reconciled costs of our specialty ticket beneficiaries for the period of July 2024 through June 2025, which resulted in additional proceeds of **\$665 thousand**, for a total of **\$1.591 million** transferred in July.

In June, the Department generated sales of **\$295.8 million** and related prize expense of **\$210.3 million**. Per the Illinois Lottery Law (20 ILCS 1605/10.3), the Department is required to collect proceeds from the sale of Lottery tickets net of prizes paid and commissions earned from authorized retailers. The proceeds resulted in cash collections of **\$105.1 million** from the weekly net sweeps of Lottery retailer's accounts and net deposits from the iLottery platform. The funds collected were deposited in the State Lottery Fund (Fund 711).

We have summarized the unaudited sales and expense activity on the accrual basis of the Department below. Please note the following activity for June is prior to year-end adjustments and will vary from final audited results.

The Department will be carrying forward a jackpot liability reserve balance of **\$18.6 million** into the following month for the Lotto (**\$11.15 million**), Mega Millions (**\$50 million**), and Powerball (**\$174 million**) jackpots. Additionally, the jackpot liability reserve includes the outstanding liability for Illinois' share of the **\$348 million** Mega Millions winner draw date June 27, 2025, and Illinois' share of the Mega Millions Tier 2 prize settlement as of draw date June 27, 2025.
