MEMORANDUM TO THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE 104TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

SUBJECT: FY 2026-2031 Proposed Multi-Year Highway and Multimodal Improvement Program (MYP)

The FY 2026-2031 Proposed Multi-Year Improvement Program (MYP) is a historic six-year \$50.6 billion investment plan for roads, bridges, transit, rail, aviation, and marine transportation infrastructure in Illinois. This investment plan is data driven with programs focusing on a broad mix of areas, including bicycle/pedestrian mobility, safety, system preservation and freight. It highlights increased transparency and responsible, innovative, and strategic investment in the state transportation system.

For Roads and Bridges, the total of the six-year program is \$32.5 billion and includes \$6.8 billion for local agencies. The program directs \$18.1 billion for other modes:

Marine: \$196.7 M	Aviation: \$1.2 B
Rail: \$2.9 B	Transit: \$13.8 B
