SUBJECT: For the Record – FY 2025

The Illinois Department of Transportation's For the Record FY 2025 is now available on the Department's website. The report compares actual awards with the Annual Highway Improvement Program that was published in August 2024.

Fiscal Year 2025 was the sixth year of the Rebuild Illinois capital program which passed in June 2019. For real time data on Rebuild Illinois Accomplishments, visit our dashboard.

The FY 2025 Annual Highway Improvement Program continued to remain significantly larger than previous years which has enabled the Department to design and implement more highway projects to address and repair our state's crumbling infrastructure.

The Department's 2025 awards included improvements on 1,356 centerline miles or 3,653 lane miles of roads, 1,285,517 square feet of deck area (129 bridges) and 196 safety and traffic improvements on the state and local systems and represents over \$4.77 billion in contracts. In 2025, the Department accomplished 89.8 percent of projects that were anticipated in the Annual Highway Improvement Program. Additionally, contracts awarded represent 78.7 percent of the Department's anticipated accomplishments in the 2025 Annual Highway Improvement Program.
