Body Worn Camera Annual Report-2025

Pursuant to the Law Enforcement Officer Body Worn Camera Act, 50 ILCS 706/10 the Grantfork Police Department (GPD) was required to institute the use of Body Worn Cameras (BWCs) on January 1, 2025. GPD uses BWCs to document encounters with the community so as to facilitate professionalism, accountability, and transparency. GPD deploys Pro-Vision BC-4 cameras.

The Grantfork Police Department has 7 employees. 1 Chief, 1 Sergeant, and 5 officers.

During the 2025 calendar year we had one issue with a bodycam, and it was replaced by Pro Vision. No video was lost.

GPD has a monthly review process in place whereas each supervisor including the Chief is directed to review 1 BWC recording of each officer and/or supervisor. Supervisors also review recordings after a reported use of force, if there is a citizen complaint, after a pursuit and to access a recruit in field training. Any "non-compliant" reviews were discussed with the officers and corrected.
