Re: Annual Body Worn Camera Report (50 ILCS 706/10-1)

Please find below and attached information required by statute pertaining to Body Worn Camera use here at the Justice Police Department.

Department Makeup:

The Justice Police Department initiated a Body Worn Camera (BWC) program in 2014. There are 25 sworn officers, with 21 of whom have been issued BWC's and are required to wear them in any law enforcement context.

Technical Issues:

The department has not experienced any specific technical issues other than on two occasions when the outside rubber coating that covers the volume or power came off. On those occasions, the camera was returned to Axon and replaced with a new one.

Review:

All videos that contain any Use of Force and Officer Complaints are reviewed by command staff to ensure adherence to laws and policy.
