Annual Report for Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Camera

50 ILCS 706/10-25

Village of Rockton Police Department

(a) The Rockton Police Department's 2025 annual report on the use of officer body -worn cameras is being submitted to the board on or before May 1st, 2026, pursuant to 50 ILCS 706/10-25 (a)(1-6).

(1) The Village of Rockton Police Department was comprised of 16 full-time sworn officers and 2 part-time sworn officers. The Village of Rockton Police Department also employed 1 full-time administrative assistant and 1 part-time administrative assistant. The ORI# for the Rockton Police Department is IL1010500.

(2) Axon BWC 4 officer-body worn cameras had been issued to all full-time and part-time officers. The Village of Rockton Police Department issued all 18 police officers with officer-worn body cameras.

(3) The Village of Rockton Police Department did not experience any technical difficulties during the reporting period of January 1st, 2025, to December 31st, 2025.

(4) Patrol Sergeants and Detective Sergeants shall review:

(4) BWC recordings per month. The Deputy Chief shall conduct (1) BWC digital recording review per month from each Patrol Sergeant under their direct supervision.

(6) The Village of Rockton Police Department followed memorandum number 21-003 which became effective and was issued on October 29th, 2021. This memorandum was pursuant to LEXIPOL Policy 435 - Portable Audio/Video Recorders. The Village of Rockton Police Department transitioned from Axon BWC 3 to Axon BWC 4 officer-worn body cameras on October 18th, 2023.
