Please find below the information required pertaining to Body body-worn camera used by the Bartlett Police Department.

Department Makeup

The Bartlett Police Department initiated a Body-Worn Camera (BWC) program in February 2024. Approximately 63 sworn officers have been issued BWCs and are required to wear them in any law enforcement context. All BWC are manufactured by AXON.

Technical Issues

The department is not experiencing any technical issues with BWC. One BWC was removed from service due to it displaying Error Code 1004 after a Use of Force incident. The BWC video was able to be downloaded, but the camera needed to be replaced. Bartlett is situated in three counties, and each county has different requirements and procedures for video sharing between our agency and the ASA offices.

Review

All videos that contain any use of force are reviewed by a Sergeant, Commander, Deputy Chief, and Chief to ensure adherence to laws and policy. Other videos are reviewed at random for monthly videos checks, or when complaints arise.
