(50 ILCS 707/15)

Sec. 15. Rules; in-car video camera grants.

(b) Each law enforcement agency receiving a grant for in-car video cameras under Section 10 of this Act must provide an annual report to the Board, the Governor, and the General Assembly on or before May 1 of the year following the receipt of the grant and by each May 1 thereafter during the period of the grant. The report shall include the following:

- (1) the number of cameras received by the law enforcement agency; **(ever?) 36**
- (2) the number of cameras actually installed in law enforcement agency vehicles; **24**
- (3) a brief description of the review process used by supervisors within the law enforcement agency; **Supervisors, including Sergeants, Lieutenants and Chiefs, will review In-Car Camera Recordings at Random, to ensure proper execution of Policies and Procedures. We will also review any and all incidents in which Use of Force and/or Complaints were made.**

(4) a list of any criminal, traffic, ordinance, and civil cases in which in-car video recordings were used, including party names, case numbers, offenses charged, and disposition of the matter. Proceedings to which this paragraph (4) applies include, but are not limited to, court proceedings, coroner's inquests, grand jury proceedings, and plea bargains; **ATTACHED**

(5) any other information relevant to the administration of the program.

(50 ILCS 707/20)

Sec. 20. Rules; officer body-worn camera grants.

(a) The Board shall develop model rules for the use of officer body-worn cameras to be adopted by law enforcement agencies that receive grants under Section 10 of this Act. The rules shall comply with the Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act.

(b) Each law enforcement agency receiving a grant for officer-worn body cameras under Section 10 of this Act must provide an annual report to the Board, the Governor, and the General Assembly on or before May 1 of the year following the receipt of the grant and by each May 1 thereafter during the period of the grant. The report shall include:

(1) a brief overview of the makeup of the agency, including the number of officers utilizing officer-worn body cameras; **38**

(2) the number of officer-worn body cameras utilized by the law enforcement agency; **40**

(3) any technical issues with the equipment and how those issues were remedied; **No**

(4) a brief description of the review process used by supervisors within the law enforcement agency; **Supervisors, including Sergeants, Lieutenants and Chiefs, will review In-Car Camera Recordings at Random, to ensure proper execution of Policies and Procedures. We will also review any and all incidents in which Use of Force and/or Complaints were made.**

(5) for each recording used in prosecutions of conservation, criminal, or traffic offenses or municipal ordinance violations: **Attached**

(6) for a recording used in a civil proceeding or internal affairs investigation:

(A) the number of pending civil proceedings and internal investigations; **0**
