To whom it may concern,

The Kenilworth Police Department currently employs 4 full time sworn Officers, 4 part time sworn Officers, 1 Sergeant, and one Chief. Our authorized staffing level is 6 full time sworn Officers. Additionally, we have a non-sworn civilian Commander position.

The Kenilworth Police Department owns 12 Axon body worn cameras. All sworn personnel have been issued body worn cameras.

In 2025 there were no reported technical issues.

On a quarterly basis, Kenilworth Police Sergeants shall randomly review at least one BWC video for each Kenilworth Patrol Officer assigned to the patrol division, to ensure the equipment is operating properly and that officers are using the cameras appropriately and in accordance with policy and training.

As soon as practicable, Kenilworth Police Sergeants shall review all BWC video associated with any encounter deemed "flagged" as defined in the Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera Act, to ensure that the equipment is operating properly and that officers are using the cameras appropriately and in accordance with policy and training.
