Pursuant to 50 ILCS 706/10-25, please find below the 2025 Body-Worn Camera Report for the Yorkville Police Department.

Department Size and Background:

The Yorkville Police Department consists of thirty-four full-time sworn officers and three Community Service Officers (CSOs). All thirty-four sworn officers have been issued individual body-worn cameras (BWCs). The CSOs have not been assigned BWCs. In May 2025, the department transitioned from Motorola V300 to Motorola V700 Body-Worn Cameras.

Technical Issues:

During 2025, one BWC malfunctioned and ceased operating properly. The device was replaced by the manufacturer, and a new unit was issued to the affected officer. Throughout the year, minor technical issues were also reported, including difficulties with video uploads, video/audio quality, and connectivity to charging docks or in-car camera systems. These issues were resolved in coordination with the manufacturer's technical support. Our distributor also reported that the Motorola V700 model may experience audio distortion when used in buildings equipped with motion-activated lighting systems. This issue results from interference with the sensors, which can cause brief audio disruptions in recorded footage.

Review Process:

Each month, every sergeant—four patrol sergeants and one detective sergeant—is responsible for reviewing four randomly selected videos from the officers under their supervision. Following these reviews, sergeants submit their findings to the Body-Worn Camera Coordinator for additional review. In addition, all BWC footage related to Use of Force incidents, citizen complaints, and pursuits is subject to mandatory review.

Attached to this correspondence is an Excel spreadsheet detailing all arrests involving body-worn camera footage between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025. The spreadsheet includes the date, time, location, report number, and offense for each case. Where available, case dispositions have also been included.
