Re: Body Worn Camera Report - FY25

Overview:

The Countryside Police Department is comprised of twenty four (24) sworn officers. Our patrol fleet includes seven (7) vehicles equipped with Motorola M500 in-car camera systems. The department has a total of twenty-five (25) Motorola V700 body worn cameras, with one issued to each officer.

Technical Issues:

The department experienced two malfunctions with the Motorola M500 in-car systems that resulted in the units not operating properly. After consulting with Motorola Solutions customer support, it was determined that the internal hard drives had failed. With the assistance of customer support, both hard drives were replaced and the units were returned to service.

Review Process:

Supervisors at the Countryside Police Department utilize a software program that randomly selects videos for review. Each week, supervisors review two (2) videos to ensure that the equipment is functioning properly and that officers are using the cameras in accordance with departmental policies and procedures.
