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2025 Fox Lake Police Department Camera Reporting Requirements (for ILETSB, State of Illinois Governor's Office and the State of Illinois General Assembly)

Below is the annual report for the Body-Worn Camera and Fleet Grant for the Fox Lake Police Department (ORI# IL0490400).

Attachments to this letter will also include the 2025 annual calendar year BWC and FLEET Reports for ILETSB.

(1) “A brief overview of the makeup of the agency, including the number of officers utilizing officer-worn body cameras.”

-The agency currently consists of 27 full time sworn police officers in which all are issued and wear body worn cameras.

(2) “The number of officer-worn body cameras utilized by the law enforcement agency.”

-Currently, thirty-three body worn cameras are owned by the agency.

(3) “Any technical issues with the equipment and how those issues were remedied.”

- There were no Axon support cases on file for our department.

(4) “A brief description of the review process used by supervisors within the law enforcement agency.”

-Our review process includes at least two randomly selected body worn camera videos per officer each month for training purposes or concerns.
Recordings will be reviewed when a complaint of misconduct or report of meritorious conduct has been made or discovered, or as part of the supervisory use of force review.

(5) “For each recording used in prosecutions of conservation, criminal, or traffic offenses or municipal ordinance violations.”
