Senator Tracy offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 716

WHEREAS, Feline infectious peritonitis (FIP) is a viral disease of cats caused by certain strains of a virus called the feline coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, Until recently, FIP was considered to be a non-treatable disease; and

WHEREAS, Once a cat develops clinical FIP, the disease is usually progressive and almost always fatal without the use of a therapy that has recently become available but has yet to be approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to treat FIP in cats; and

WHEREAS, Two drugs, GS-5734, also known as remdesivir, and GS-441524, a metabolite of remdesivir, showed very promising results, generating cure rates between 80% and 100% in both artificially and naturally infected cats; and

WHEREAS, Studies in both the laboratory and in client-owned cats with naturally occurring FIP suggest that GS-441524 may ultimately prove to be an effective treatment option for the effusive form of FIP; however, GS-441524 is currently not FDA-approved; and

WHEREAS, While a number of sources offer GS-441524 for sale, reports suggest that the products being provided by some of these sources vary widely in both accuracy of reported drug concentration and purity; and

WHEREAS, While remdesivir was pursued as a treatment for severely ill COVID-19 patients, the company that developed it did not seek approval for the other molecule as a veterinary drug, fearing that any undesirable effects discovered for that molecule could hinder approval of remdesivir for human use; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we encourage the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to approve GS-441524 and remdesivir to treat feline infectious peritonitis (FIP) in cats; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to all members of the Illinois Congressional Delegation and the Food and Drug Administration.

WHEREAS, Using advanced technology, court reporters write in shorthand, a simultaneous verbatim report of the spoken word, in pretrial depositions and hearings, trials, arbitrations, and sworn statements, which are the critical foundation to the pursuit of justice in every legal proceeding; and

WHEREAS, Illinois shorthand reporters and real-time captioners provide Communication Access Realtime Translation (CART) by captioning for attorneys, litigants, and jurors in legal proceedings, at business meetings, at educational classes and lectures, at sporting events, and at arts performances for many

Illinoisans who are deaf or hard-of-hearing, have auditory processing disabilities, or for whom English is not their first language; and

WHEREAS, Court reporters and captioners preserve history for all Americans by translating spoken word into readable, searchable, storable, and usable text and electronic media; and

WHEREAS, Illinois CSRs are licensed by the State as the services provided by shorthand reporters and court reporters have long been declared to affect the public health, safety, and welfare of the people of Illinois; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare February 3 through February 10, 2024 as Court Reporting and Captioning Week in the State of Illinois.
