PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Plummer offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 771

WHEREAS, On October 7, 2023, terrorists launched a horrific assault on the State of Israel from Hamas-controlled Gaza, murdering hundreds of unarmed civilians and kidnapping women, children, and the elderly; and

WHEREAS, The assault commenced as the Jewish people and the diaspora celebrated the holidays of Sukkot and Shemini Atzeret/Simchat Torah; and

WHEREAS, Hamas terrorists crossed the border into Israel and began targeting unarmed civilians, which included countless incidents of rape, torture, and untold cruelty while killing at least 1,400 people, becoming the largest targeted killing of those of Jewish descent since the Holocaust; and

WHEREAS, Hamas terrorists intentionally targeted unarmed civilians and killed many, including at least 260 people murdered at the Tribe of Nova, an Israeli music festival for peace, in the largest massacre in Israel's history; and

WHEREAS, Hamas terrorists kidnapped at least 240 innocent civilians, including women, children, and infants, from Israel and forced them across the border into Gaza; and

WHEREAS, Illinoisans were victimized in this horrific act, and many Illinois families have been impacted; and

WHEREAS, The attack on Israel was an attack on the world as citizens from multiple countries were victims, including at least 31 American citizens, as well as citizens from Canada, the United Kingdom, France, Thailand, Nepal, Philippines, Germany, Cambodia, Brazil, Paraguay, Russia, Ukraine, Mexico, Ireland, and other nations; and

WHEREAS, In response to these terrorist attacks, the State of Israel declared war on Hamas; and

WHEREAS, Since October 7, 2023, the death toll in Israel and Gaza has continued to rise; and

WHEREAS, The Hamas terrorist attacks were motivated in part to derail peace talks in the region between Israel and other Middle East nations, including Saudi Arabia; and

WHEREAS, Israel, like all sovereign nations, has the right and obligation to protect its citizens from terrorist attacks and hostile foreign powers; and

WHEREAS, These events delay peace, have and will continue to create instability, spur an increase in hostile activity against peaceful citizens, and endanger deployed American civilians, government employees, and military personnel; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we condemn the terrorist attacks by Hamas on the State of Israel, express our deepest sorrow to all innocent people impacted by this terrorist attack and for all the innocent lives lost in Israel and Gaza, call for the safe delivery of humanitarian aid for the region, demand the release of the hostages being held by Hamas, pray for all deployed Americans, and oppose all organizations that use terror as a tactic, victimize innocent civilians, and intentionally undermine peace throughout the world.

Senator Villanueva offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 774

WHEREAS, The future of our nation's productivity and competitiveness in the global marketplace depends on the success of all men and women; and

WHEREAS, Women have been discriminated against in education, the workplace, and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Equal Pay Day, representing all women, is celebrated this year on March 12; this date is based on U.S. Census figures showing that the average woman who works full-time is paid on average just 84% of the typical man's pay; started by the National Committee on Pay Equity (NCPE) in 1996, the goal of Equal Pay Day is to raise awareness about the gender wage gap; and

WHEREAS, In 2022, changes were made to the methodology, and The Equal Pay Day Calendar now encompasses a broader cross-section of women, including those who work part-time or seasonally, to represent a more accurate picture of how the gender pay gap impacts diverse communities; the COVID-19 pandemic pushed many women, especially women of color, into part-time or seasonal work or out of the workforce all together; because of this, past methods of calculating the wage gap fell short of accurately capturing the full picture; with the new inclusive methodology, we can advocate on behalf of all women in the workforce; and

WHEREAS, Because the pay gap varies significantly among different communities, other Equal Pay Days have been added to the calendar over the years to reflect the fact that many women must work far longer into the year to catch up to men; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQIA+ Equal Pay Awareness Day is June 15; this day raises awareness about the wage gap experienced by the LGBTQIA+ community; and

WHEREAS, Black Women's Equal Pay Day is July 27; Black women working full-time and year-round are paid 69 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 66 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Moms' Equal Pay Day is August 15; moms working full-time and year-round are paid 74 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 62 cents for every dollar paid to dads; and

WHEREAS, Latina's Equal Pay Day is October 5; Latina women working full-time and year-round are paid 57 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 52 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Native Women's Equal Pay Day is November 30; Native women working full-time and year-round are paid 59 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 55 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Asian American, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander Women's Equal Pay Day is also held each year on April 5; Asian American women working full-time and year-round are paid 99 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 89 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander women working full-time and year-round are paid 65 cents, and all earners (including part-time and seasonal) are paid 61 cents for ever dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, The pay gap has been shown to start as soon as one year after college; this inequality affects not only women but also their families and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, The pay gap between women and men has long-term effects on women's economic security; such a gap affects women's Social Security earnings, their ability to save for retirement, and their children's education; and

WHEREAS, Pay equity is closely linked to the eradication of poverty and is essential to having a highly-motivated workforce; and

WHEREAS, Equal pay is a priority for all women and for our society at large; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare March 12, 2024 as "Equal Pay Day" in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage the citizens of this State to learn about the pay gap that women experience in society and to learn about these various dates that bring attention to the pay gap that specific groups experience.

WHEREAS, While Lunar New Year celebrations vary in length from culture to culture, ranging from three days to two weeks, celebration commonalities include gathering with family and friends, honoring ancestors and elders, watching and participating in traditional dances, settling disputes, exchanging gifts, and enjoying feasts; and

WHEREAS, The Lunar New Year occurs in a 12-year cycle, with each year being represented by one of 12 animals from the zodiac; and

WHEREAS, In Chinese, Korean, and Vietnamese Lunar New Year celebrations, the 2024 Lunar New Year is the Year of the Dragon, symbolizing courage, good fortune, honor, prosperity, and success; and

WHEREAS, This year, the Lunar New Year will begin on February 10, 2024; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we recognize the cultural and historical significance of the Lunar New Year to Asian American communities, express our deepest respect for Asian Americans and people
