WHEREAS, Disc golf is perfect for anyone looking to teach, share, and enjoy a lifetime sport; it is a healthy, inexpensive activity that provides upper and lower body conditioning, aerobic exercise, and mental stimulation; played on a course with nine or 18 holes, players aim to reach a basket by throwing a disc from a tee pad, with the goal of completing each hole in the fewest throws; the sport is played in approximately 40 countries and, as of April 26, 2023, boasts 107,853 active members of the Professional Disc Golf Association (PDGA) worldwide; and

WHEREAS, In the 1920s, the earliest known games of disc golf were played by children at Bladworth Elementary School in Saskatchewan, Canada; and

WHEREAS, In 1976, the success of disc golf at the World Frisbee Championships suggested that this sport was the next big thing, and Ed Headrick created the Disc Golf Association (DGA); even today, it functions as a leader in the sport; and

WHEREAS, In 1977, one of the earliest courses with baskets installed, though no longer in existence, was created by Ed Headrick, known as the Father of Disc Golf, in Gilson Park in Wilmette; and

WHEREAS, In the fall of 2014, The Canyons opened, built by volunteers at Dellwood Park in Lockport; in 2024, UDisc ranked The Canyons as the 17th best disc golf course and the 2nd best free course in the world; and

WHEREAS, On June 3, 2021, the City of Chicago saw its first 18 hole course in Jackson Park, utilizing temporary baskets funded by individual donations and the support of the Paul McBeth Foundation and maintained by volunteers of the nonprofit Hyde Park Disc Golf; and

WHEREAS, Northwood Black in Morton is considered one of the most difficult courses on the professional tour and is home of The LedgeStone Open, which is recognized as one of the biggest disc golf events in the world, both in terms of participants and size of the professional prize purse; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Park in Springfield hosts the Deaf Central Open on June 1st and 2nd, serving as the regional qualifier for Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) disc golfers, and is celebrated for its challenging layout and inclusive community spirit, attracting participants from across the Midwest; and

WHEREAS, Disc golf is so popular and rapidly growing that there are 11,300 courses globally, with 75 percent of all disc golf courses being in the United States, 369 courses in Illinois alone, ranking it as the 4th best state for course availability and 13th best state for course variety as reported in the Disc Golf Health Index; and

WHEREAS, Disc golf is accessible and enjoyable for people of all socioeconomic classes, age groups, and demographics and provides a way to exercise, a way to spend time outdoors, and a wide range of health benefits; and

WHEREAS, Disc golf is a sport that, when the infrastructure is available, takes only minutes to learn yet provides a lifetime of enjoyment in the natural world; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare the month of August 2024 as Illinois Disc Golf Month and August 10, 2024 as Illinois Disc Golf Day, recognizing the teamwork and physical, mental, and emotional well-being the sport provides.

WHEREAS, It is fitting and proper to celebrate with the Indian people and to reaffirm the democratic principles on which our two great nations were born; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we recognize the 77th anniversary of India's Independence on August 15, 2024.

WHEREAS, October is nationally recognized as Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, Breast cancer is the most common type of cancer among women globally and the second leading cause of cancer death among women in the United States; and

WHEREAS, More than one in eight women and one in 833 men in the United States will be diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetimes; and

WHEREAS, An estimated 313,510 Americans will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer in 2024; and

WHEREAS, Metastatic breast cancer (MBC) occurs when breast cancer spreads to other parts of the body, including the bones, lungs, liver, and brain, and individuals with MBC have an average life expectancy of 24 to 36 months after diagnosis; and

WHEREAS, Regardless of early detection, approximately 30% of stage 0 to stage III breast cancers will return as stage IV; and

WHEREAS, An estimated 42,780 Americans will die from breast cancer in 2024, equal to 117 women and men per day, with 98% of deaths being caused by MBC; and

WHEREAS, MBC affects all races and socioeconomic classes; and

WHEREAS, While white women see slightly higher incidence rates of breast cancer, the mortality rate for Black women with breast cancer is 41% higher than that of white women, and breast cancer is the leading cause of cancer-related death for Hispanic women; and

WHEREAS, METAvivor Research and Support, a national organization, funds critical stage IV metastatic breast cancer research and educates the public about metastatic breast cancer and the lack of funding for stage IV treatment; and

WHEREAS, METAvivor aims to dramatically increase the current percentage of breast cancer research dollars for already metastasized patients from under 5% to 30%; and

WHEREAS, The national hashtags for this initiative on social media fall under #METAvivor and #LightUpMBC, with the latter representing a global campaign designed to educate, raise funds, and shine a light on the critical need for stage IV metastatic breast cancer research; and

WHEREAS, The #LightUpMBC campaign, held annually on October 13, illuminates 117 landmarks around the world in the metastatic breast cancer colors of teal, pink, and green to bring awareness to the disease and to honor the daily number of 117 lives lost to MBC; and

WHEREAS, While the pink ribbon is well-known for representing the fight against early stage breast cancer, it is not inclusive of stage IV; therefore, the metastatic breast cancer awareness tricolor ribbon includes teal to portray healing and spirituality, green for the triumph of spring over winter, life over death, renewal, hope, and immortality, and a thin pink overlay to signify that the cancer originated in the breast; and

WHEREAS, The #LightUpMBC campaign will culminate in a virtual broadcast, #LightUpMBC Live, to commemorate landmarks lighting up around the world, to share inspiring stories by the metastatic breast cancer community, and to raise research funds; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare October 13, 2024 as Metastatic Breast Cancer Awareness Day in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we recognize the METAvivor #LightUpMBC national campaign; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage citizens to join the national effort towards awareness of metastatic breast cancer during October through METAvivor; and be it further

WHEREAS, Idling freight trains contribute to air pollution and adversely affect the air quality in nearby communities, and the routing of hazardous materials throughout the country creates significant risks to public safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, Additionally, the operation of long freight trains can divide communities, impede emergency response times, and increase the risk of derailments, posing threats to both residents and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Immediate action is needed to address delays that result in idling freight trains, which have harmful environmental impacts on our local communities and create blocked at-grade crossings, which adversely impact public safety and harm economic development; and

WHEREAS, The placement of grade separations would increase the capacity by allowing constant flow in all directions, thereby removing crossing traffic from intersections and improving the safety of our roadways through reducing vehicle-vehicle and vehicle-pedestrian conflicts and collisions; and

WHEREAS, The long-term benefits of reduced air pollution, enhanced public safety, and minimized risks of derailments can result in significant cost savings for both the government and affected communities; and

WHEREAS, By addressing these critical concerns and implementing proposed policy measures, we can protect the environment from air pollution, ensure train safety, reduce risks associated with the transportation of hazardous materials, and promote the well-being of communities across the State; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge Congress and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), in collaboration with local and other relevant stakeholders, to take immediate action to address delays that result in idling freight trains by installing additional tracks or other measures in order to reduce environmental impacts and blocked at-grade crossings; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we urge the FRA to create recommendations on the strategic placement of grade separations and mandate reasonable lengths of freight trains as determined by comprehensive federal studies and assessments that identify risks associated with long freight trains and encourage the reduction of the length of trains, including public safety impacts and any increased risks of derailment; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we urge the FRA, in order to enhance public safety and minimize the risks associated with the transportation of hazardous materials, to undertake a study to determine safer, innovative methods of routing these materials through the country, with the study incorporating a full assessment of railways in relation to critical infrastructure and explosive materials, including fueling stations and gas lines, an assessment of community communication with an emphasis on first responders, a review of safety

standards for rail cars, a consideration of the use of advanced technology and risk assessment tools to determine the safest and most efficient routing options for hazardous materials, and a current assessment of track conditions; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we support funding for impacted counties for research, development, and collaboration efforts.

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare September 15-21, 2024 as Surgical Technologists Week in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we recognize the 55,000 surgical technologists who hold certified surgical technologist (CST) credentials as they celebrate National Surgical Technologists Week from September 15-21, 2024; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Association of Surgical Technologists as a symbol of our respect and esteem.

WHEREAS, Of the 2 million Americans the American Cancer Society estimates will be diagnosed with cancer in 2024, more than 78,000 individuals are predicted to be diagnosed in Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Cancer care is increasingly reliant on genetic and genomic testing to direct care for each individual patient; and

WHEREAS, It is now understood that access to multidisciplinary supportive care while undergoing treatment can significantly impact outcomes and survival for cancer patients; and

WHEREAS, There is a growing understanding that there are hundreds of different cancer types and each may require different types of therapy; the complexities of cancer care include relying on the accuracy of the initial diagnosis, the choice of therapy, and access to appropriate clinical trials; and

WHEREAS, There is significant variability in the ability of medical oncologists to stay current with the most recent evidence due to the complexities of cancer care in the precision medicine era; and

WHEREAS, For many cancer patients, the first chance for a cure is the best chance for a cure, highlighting the need for access to appropriate expertise early in the cancer journey; and

WHEREAS, There are disparities in cancer outcomes and access to leading-edge clinical trials based on race and socioeconomic status that are unfavorable to those that are the most vulnerable and disadvantaged; and

WHEREAS, The speed of discovery in cancer diagnosis, treatment, and surveillance is creating a widening gap between the optimal care received by those with means and the substandard care too often received by the most vulnerable residents of Illinois, which will only worsen if it is not addressed; this reality reflects an important truth that cancer care is different from other types of health care, and the needs of cancer patients are different from those with other illnesses; and

WHEREAS, It is imperative that Illinois policymakers prioritize appropriate and timely access to expert cancer care for patients; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we endorse the following principles as the Cancer Patients' Bill of Rights to express our support that cancer patients in the State receive the best cancer care available:

(1) Cancer patients with complex cancers deserve access to specialized expertise and emerging treatments for their specific type of cancer, including precision medicine and genomic therapies, which are only available at advanced cancer centers;

(2) Cancer patients deserve multidisciplinary supportive care while undergoing treatment, including care that addresses pain, emotional, and overall health needs;

(3) Cancer patients should have the opportunity to access emerging therapies informed by the latest cancer research through relevant early-stage and late-stage clinical trials, which are often only available at cancer treatment institutions;

(4) To the extent possible, cancer patients should be able to receive timely cancer care in their community, which is often supported by partnerships between community providers and academic institutions; and

(5) Cancer patients have a right to fully understand their diagnoses and be informed about treatment options in culturally appropriate and understandable languages; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies be delivered to Governor JB Pritzker and Director Elizabeth M. Whitehorn of the Department of Healthcare and Family Services.

WHEREAS, The long list of allegations that have been overlooked by State officials for years includes sex trafficking of minors, staffers who should never have been hired in the first place because of disqualifying prior arrests, overlooked claims of guards using sexual innuendos with children, staffers sleeping on the job, staffers sharing pornographic videos among themselves at work, and thousands of reported violent attacks among young residents; and

WHEREAS, Officials at the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services offered a delayed response to the situation at Aunt Martha's Integrated Care Center and began to monitor the facility with 24-hour on-site supervision in May, nine months after the first report of sexual assault by a staffer; within weeks, the facility was shuttered; therefore, be it
