PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTIONS

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 103

WHEREAS, The President of the United States and the United States Congress have a responsibility to be transparent when making decisions in regard to funding federal programs; and

WHEREAS, The President of the United States should not be impounding funds without providing complete transparency and ample notice; and

WHEREAS, Congress should not be reducing vital program funding for our neediest communities; and

WHEREAS, The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Medicaid, housing assistance, and other federally funded programs are essential to supporting low-income individuals and families in Illinois and across the United States; and

WHEREAS, The President of the United States has a duty to ensure that federal funding intended for the neediest communities is allocated and distributed as directed by Congress; and

WHEREAS, The Impoundment Control Act of 1974 restricts the executive branch from unilaterally withholding or delaying congressionally appropriated funds without legislative approval; and

WHEREAS, Any action to cut, impound, or reduce federal funding for essential services could disproportionately harm vulnerable populations, including seniors, children, individuals with disabilities, and low-income families; and

WHEREAS, The economic stability and well-being of the neediest communities depend on the timely and full disbursement of federal funds for programs addressing food security, healthcare, housing, and education; and

WHEREAS, Reducing or delaying these funds could result in increased poverty, food insecurity, homelessness, and worsening health outcomes for millions of Americans, including residents of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Ensuring the full distribution of these funds aligns with the principles of equity, justice, and economic opportunity for all citizens; and

WHEREAS, Congress has the constitutional power of the purse, and the executive branch must uphold its duty to implement spending as enacted by the legislative branch; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the President of the United States and Congress to ensure they will not cut, impound, or reduce funding for the neediest communities in Illinois and across the United States and to fully comply with the congressional intent behind federally appropriated funds; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to the President of the United States, the U.S. Senate Majority Leader, the U.S. Senate Minority Leader, the U.S. Speaker of the House, the U.S. House of Representatives Minority Leader, and all members of the Illinois Congressional Delegation.

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 104

WHEREAS, Public libraries serve as essential community institutions that provide access to information, education, and cultural resources to all residents; and

WHEREAS, The governance and oversight of public libraries is entrusted to library trustees who play a critical role in ensuring that libraries operate efficiently, equitably, and in the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, Library trustees must navigate complex legal, financial, and policy matters, including issues of intellectual freedom, budgeting, and community engagement; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the Illinois Secretary of State provides training and educational resources for library trustees to enhance their knowledge of their responsibilities and the best practices in library governance; and

WHEREAS, Continuing education and training for library trustees is vital to maintaining strong and well-functioning libraries that serve the diverse needs of Illinois residents; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge all public library trustees to participate in ongoing training programs provided by the Illinois Secretary of State to strengthen their ability to effectively oversee library operations and services; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage the Illinois Secretary of State to expand and enhance library trustee training opportunities, ensuring that all library board members have access to comprehensive education on governance, ethics, and policy matters; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to Illinois Secretary of State Alexi Giannoulias, the Illinois State Library, and all public library boards in the State of Illinois.

Senator Fine offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 105

WHEREAS, Serious mental illnesses like bipolar disorder, major depressive disorder, and schizophrenia often require treatment with antipsychotic medications for effective management, and antipsychotic prescribing rates continue to rise; and

WHEREAS, While prolonged antipsychotic use may be essential for the treatment of certain conditions, it is associated with tardive dyskinesia (TD), a condition marked by uncontrollable, abnormal, and repetitive movements of the face, torso, limbs, or extremities; and

WHEREAS, People at higher risk of TD include those older than 55 years, people who are Black, women, individuals with mood or substance use disorders, intellectual disabilities, or central nervous system injuries, and those with high cumulative antipsychotic exposure; and

WHEREAS, Approximately 60% of the estimated 800,000 U.S. adults living with TD remain undiagnosed, and even mild TD symptoms can be stigmatizing and impair physical, social, and emotional well-being, underscoring the urgency of early screening, detection, and intervention; and

WHEREAS, The American Psychiatric Association recommends routine TD screening in their clinical guidelines for antipsychotic treatment, and individuals treated with antipsychotics or experiencing abnormal movements should consult their health care providers to assess TD risk, receive TD screenings, and determine appropriate treatment together; and

WHEREAS, FDA-approved treatments for TD can provide options for symptom management and improved quality of life for many individuals living with TD; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly can encourage TD screening education and awareness for health care providers, patients, and care partners to help ensure patients prescribed antipsychotics receive care and support that aligns with clinical best practices, including regular TD screenings; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare May 4 through May 10, 2025 as Tardive Dyskinesia Awareness Week (TDAW) in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we support TDAW in recognition of the importance of early detection and intervention to improve outcomes for people living with mental health conditions and prescribed antipsychotics, and we support efforts to raise awareness about the causes and symptoms of tardive dyskinesia (TD) and the importance of routine TD screening.
