PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Martwick offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 113

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois is home to a diverse and vibrant workforce that contributes significantly to the economic success and growth of our State; and

WHEREAS, As our population continues to age, the importance of securing financial stability and independence in retirement becomes increasingly evident for individuals of all socioeconomic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, It is universally recognized that retirement savings are essential for maintaining financial well-being in later years as well as for promoting dignity, security, and a high quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Despite the importance of preparing for retirement, many workers across Illinois lack access to retirement savings options or face barriers to participation in employer-sponsored retirement plans, which can lead to financial insecurity in their later years; and

WHEREAS, Employers, as key partners in the workforce, have an ethical obligation to provide their employees with access to retirement savings options as part of their responsibility to support their employees' long-term financial health and security; and

WHEREAS, Offering retirement options, such as 401(k) plans, IRAs, or other retirement savings programs, not only benefits employees but also strengthens our State's economy by ensuring that workers can retire with confidence and continue to contribute to the State's consumer spending and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, The retirement community is a critical segment of the Illinois economy whose members drive demand for goods and services and create jobs across various industries, including healthcare, housing, and entertainment, all of which enhance the quality of life for Illinois residents; and

WHEREAS, Employers who provide retirement plans demonstrate a commitment to the long-term well-being of their employees, fostering loyalty, improving employee morale, and helping to retain a talented workforce; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we recognize the moral responsibility of all employers to ensure their valued employees have a path to secure retirement, and as such, we urge employers across the State to provide quality retirement savings options for their employees in recognition of the importance of securing financial independence in retirement and the positive impact that it will have on the well-being of both individual employees and the State's economy as a whole.

Senator Loughran Cappel offered the following Senate Joint Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 19

WHEREAS, Policymakers have strongly advocated for efforts to elevate the importance of retaining diverse and inclusive educators in Illinois; and

WHEREAS, The Performance Evaluation Reform Act (PERA), Public Act 96-0861, was signed into law by the governor in January 2010 and required school districts and other covered entities to include student growth as a "significant factor" in evaluating principals, assistant principals, and teachers by certain implementation dates; the law also required that evaluations include a four category rating system and regulated training programs for anyone undertaking such evaluations; PA 97-8, an offshoot of PERA, introduced the use of educators' evaluation rating outcomes into employment decisions in a number of ways, including the standards for certificate/license actions against an educator for incompetency, acquisition of tenure, reductions in force/layoffs, and recall rights; and

WHEREAS, PERA also created the Illinois Performance Evaluation Advisory Council, which recommended the Danielson Framework for Teaching to all districts for use in evaluating educators' professional practice in 2011; later, the State's evaluator training materials incorporated the Danielson Framework for Teaching for use as a training tool for all teacher evaluators; and

WHEREAS, Teacher diversity has been linked to improved student outcomes, including increased academic achievement, higher rates of gifted assignment, and lower rates of exclusionary discipline; to recognize these benefits, there has been a growing research and policy focus on recruiting and hiring teachers of color; however, studies have shown that teachers of color have high turnover rates, so retention of teachers of color has also become an important part of the conversation; and

WHEREAS, Research from Blazar (2024) finds that Black teachers:

- (1) Have statistically significant positive impacts on Black students' self-efficacy;
- (2) Enhance students', particularly Black students', engagement in classes;
- (3) Improve student attendance, reducing absences by 47% for Black students and 22% for non-Black students;
- (4) Improve math test scores of both Black and non-Black students; and
- (5) Produce long-term benefits in English language arts test scores, particularly for Black students; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois State Board of Education began reporting the three-year teacher retention rate disaggregated by race/ethnicity for the first time in 2021; the data showed that Illinois schools retain Black teachers at the lowest rate of all teacher groups, 80.6 percent, compared to an 87.6 percent rate for White teachers; and

WHEREAS, After a year-long study, the Illinois State Board of Education released the Teacher Evaluation Research Project (2024), a research report that found the State's current evaluation requirements result in the following:

- (1) A heavy workload, and at times, a burden on both teachers and evaluators, which minimizes opportunities to prioritize actionable feedback and professional growth for all educators;
- (2) Concerns about the presence of bias in evaluations, particularly regarding student growth measures; and
- (3) Disparities in rating distributions by educators' race and school district characteristics, with serious and significant negative impacts on Black and Latinx educators; and

WHEREAS, Since 2011, when Illinois recommended the Danielson Framework for Teaching as an evaluation tool, there have been lingering questions about potential biases built into Danielson Framework for Teaching itself, which could be contributing to the disparities in rating outcomes that we are seeing in Illinois and go beyond potential individual evaluator bias, and whether or not the tool is fair to Black and Brown educators in their work with all types of students, including students with disabilities, multilingual learners, and early learners; further, there has yet to be a clear body of evidence to demonstrate that the Danielson Framework for Teaching is a robust instrument, which would foster the equity-based teaching practices and reflective conversations that are envisioned in the Illinois Culturally Responsive Teaching and Leading Standards; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that we urge the Illinois State Board of Education to initiate and complete a research study to examine the application and use of the Danielson Framework for Teaching, including ways to confront ideological barriers to socially just teacher performance evaluation; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois State Board of Education is urged to deliver this report to the legislature by June 30, 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be delivered to the Illinois State Board of Education.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT NO. 5**

SC0005

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to amend Section 7 of Article III of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

ARTICLE III
SUFFRAGE AND ELECTIONS

(ILCON Art. III, Sec. 1)

SECTION 1. VOTING QUALIFICATIONS

Every United States citizen who has attained the age of 18 or any other voting age required by the United States for voting ~~in State elections~~ and who has been a permanent resident of this State for at least 30 days next preceding any election shall have the right to vote at such election. The General Assembly by law may establish registration requirements and require permanent residence in an election district not to exceed thirty days prior to an election. The General Assembly by law may establish shorter residence requirements for voting for President and Vice-President of the United States.

WHEREAS, The Constitution of the State of Illinois prescribes a flat, or non-graduated, income tax system be utilized; and

WHEREAS, In 2020, the General Assembly put the progressive income tax amendment on the 2020 ballot, which would have altered our Constitution and permitted graduated income tax rates and tax increases on all Illinoisans; and

WHEREAS, The progressive income tax amendment was roundly rejected by Illinoisans in the 2020 election; and

WHEREAS, Current inflation levels, rising costs, and recession fears are already wreaking havoc on household budgets of Illinoisans across the state; and

WHEREAS, Illinoisans already have one of the highest total tax burdens in the country; and

WHEREAS, The State of Illinois is currently collecting record sums of revenue; and

WHEREAS, Since rejecting the progressive income tax amendment in 2020, five states have transitioned away from a progressive income tax to a flat, non-graduated income tax; and

WHEREAS, In addition to imposing a tax increase through a progressive income tax upon over-taxed Illinoisans, this tax increase would deprive the state of one of the few competitive advantages Illinois has to retain and attract businesses; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we trust the decision Illinoisans made in 2020 when they rejected the path to future tax increases by rejecting and prohibiting the progressive income tax amendment from becoming enacted; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois Senate rejects all efforts to raise taxes on Illinoisans by further attempts to change the state's Constitution and transition away from the flat tax to a progressive income tax; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to all Illinois Constitutional Officers, the President and Minority Leader of the Illinois Senate, and the Speaker and Minority Leader of the Illinois House of Representatives.

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to amend Article IV of the Illinois Constitution by changing Section 8 as follows:

ARTICLE IV
THE LEGISLATURE

(ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 8)

SECTION 8. PASSAGE OF BILLS

(a) The enacting clause of the laws of this State shall be: "Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly."

(b) The General Assembly shall enact laws only by bill. Bills may originate in either house, but may be amended or rejected by the other.

(c) No bill shall become a law without the concurrence of a majority of the members elected to each house. Final passage of a bill shall be by record vote. In the Senate at the request of two members, and in the House at the request of five members, a record vote may be taken on any other occasion. A record vote is a vote by yeas and nays entered on the journal.

(d) A bill shall be read by title on three different days in each house. A bill and each amendment thereto shall be reproduced and placed on the desk of each member before final passage. Final passage of a bill or amendment, except bills for appropriations, may not occur until at least 24 hours after being introduced. Final passage of bills for appropriations may not occur until at least 72 hours after being introduced.

Bills, except bills for appropriations and for the codification, revision or rearrangement of laws, shall be confined to one subject. Appropriation bills shall be limited to the subject of appropriations.

A bill expressly amending a law shall set forth completely the sections amended.

The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate shall sign each bill that passes both houses to certify that the procedural requirements for passage have been met.
