**PRESENTATION OF RESOLUTIONS**

Senator Villanueva offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

**SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 154**

WHEREAS, March has served as Women's History Month since 1987, and women of all races and ethnicities continue to impact and influence not only their families but also the next generation of leaders; and

WHEREAS, Latina women have made an impressive impact on the State of Illinois and are a driving force behind Illinois' economic growth; they now compose the largest group of women workers in the U.S., behind non-Hispanic Caucasian women; currently numbering over 14 million, they account for 17% of the female labor force and are projected to rapidly continue growing; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Legislative Latino Caucus (ILLC), established in 2002, has diligently worked to preserve and protect Latina heritage while supporting Latina women in legislative leadership positions in the Illinois Senate and House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, Designed to increase federal, state, and municipal resources that benefit Illinois Latinos, the ILLC has been vigilant in making sure members of their community have the proper necessities to become successful and create a legacy of which generations to come will be proud; and

WHEREAS, The ILLC blazes a path for women in leadership to continue striving for greatness while making unprecedented decisions that improve the quality of life for Black and Brown communities; and

WHEREAS, The ILLC has become the voice for Latino communities in Illinois seeking change and equality and will continue preserving the history of its people; and

WHEREAS, Establishing Latina Heritage Day in Illinois provides a dedicated time to celebrate and recognize the cultural and historical contributions of Latinas, as well as raise awareness of the challenges they continue to face; and

WHEREAS, Latina Heritage Day will serve as an opportunity to uplift the voices and achievements of Latinas, promote civic engagement, and inspire future generations to continue the legacy of leadership and advocacy; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare March 15, 2025 as Latina Heritage Day in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Illinois Legislative Latino Caucus (ILLC) as a symbol of our esteem and respect.

Senator Villanueva offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

#### **SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 158**

WHEREAS, The future of our nation's productivity and competitiveness in the global marketplace depends on the success of all men and women; and

WHEREAS, Women have been discriminated against in education, the workplace, and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Equal Pay Day, started by the National Committee on Pay Equity (NCPE) in 1996, was created with the goal of raising awareness about the gender wage gap; this symbolic day further highlights and combats the impact of pay inequities through U.S. Census data, which has revealed that women working full-time and year-round are paid 83% of what men are paid, and all workers, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 75% of what men are paid; and

WHEREAS, In 2022, changes were made to the methodology, and The Equal Pay Day Calendar now encompasses a broader cross-section of women, including those who work part-time or seasonally, to represent a more accurate picture of how the gender pay gap impacts diverse communities; the COVID-19 pandemic pushed many women, especially women of color, into part-time or seasonal work or out of the workforce all together; because of this, past methods of calculating the wage gap fell short of accurately

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capturing the full picture; with the new inclusive methodology, we can advocate on behalf of all women in the workforce; and

WHEREAS, Because the pay gap varies significantly among different communities, other Equal Pay Days have been added to the calendar over the years to reflect the fact that many women must work far longer into the year to catch up to men; and

WHEREAS, Equal Pay Day, which represents all women, is to be celebrated on March 25 this year; and

WHEREAS, Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Women's Equal Pay Day is April 7 this year; AANHPI women working full-time and year-round are paid 94 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 83 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Moms' Equal Pay Day is May 6 this year; mothers working full-time and year-round are paid 71 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 63 cents for every dollar paid to fathers; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQIA+ Equal Pay Awareness Day is June 17 this year; this day raises awareness about the wage gap experienced by the LGBTQIA+ community; and

WHEREAS, Black Women's Equal Pay Day is July 10 this year; Black women working full-time and year-round are paid 66 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 64 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander (NHPI) Women's Equal Pay Day is August 28 this year; NHPI women working full-time and year-round are paid 65 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 61 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Latina Equal Pay Day is October 8 this year; Latinas working full-time and year-round are paid 58 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 51 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Disabled Women's Equal Pay Day is October 23 this year; disabled women working full-time and year-round are paid 72 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 50 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, Native Women's Equal Pay Day is November 18 this year; Native women working full-time and year-round are paid 58 cents, and all earners, including part-time and seasonal, are paid 52 cents for every dollar paid to non-Hispanic white men; and

WHEREAS, The pay gap has been shown to start as soon as one year after college, and this inequality affects not only women but also their families and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, The pay gap between women and men has long-term effects on women's economic security, and such a gap affects women's Social Security earnings, their ability to save for retirement, and their children's education; and

WHEREAS, Pay equity is closely linked to the eradication of poverty and is essential to having a highly-motivated workforce; and

WHEREAS, Equal pay is a priority for all women and for our society at large; therefore, be it

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RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare March 25, 2025 as Equal Pay Day in the State of Illinois; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage the citizens of this State to learn about the pay gap that women experience in society and to learn about these various dates that bring attention to the pay gap that specific groups experience.

Senator Edly-Allen offered the following Senate Resolution, which was referred to the Committee on Assignments:

#### SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 159

WHEREAS, Maintaining proper oral hygiene and preserving natural teeth are essential steps to ensuring optimal oral health, which impacts patients' overall health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, Each year, over 25 million teeth are preserved through endodontic treatments, including 15 million root canal procedures, emphasizing the importance of saving natural teeth for improved appearance and maintaining essential functions such as chewing and speech; and

WHEREAS, Endodontists, as highly skilled dental specialists, excel in diagnosing and treating tooth pain and infection through life-changing endodontic procedures, including root canals, trauma dental injuries, vital pulp therapy, and apicoectomies, that safeguard their patients' natural teeth; with three additional years of training post-dental school, they utilize advanced technology and specialized care to best treat tooth pain and infection; and

WHEREAS, Endodontists dedicate their dental practice exclusively to endodontic treatments, performing an average of 25 root canal treatments weekly; they frequently collaborate with general dentists to ensure comprehensive dental care and employ a specialized approach, leading to better health outcomes and a swifter recovery for patients; and

WHEREAS, Teeth serve as vital components for nutrition, emotional expression, and overall health indicators, and neglecting oral hygiene can lead to various health complications; regular dental visits, thorough brushing and flossing twice daily, and avoiding cavity-causing foods and habits are essential steps in maintaining gum, teeth, and mouth health; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare May 2025 as Save Your Tooth Month in the State of Illinois, and we acknowledge endodontists as leaders dedicated to saving patients' natural teeth; and be it further

RESOLVED, That we encourage the citizens of Illinois to practice good oral hygiene to save their natural teeth.
